NMPFBA Members Representing at 2025 World Firefighter Challenge



2025 Mountain Biking Event to be a Downhill Poker Run in the Awatere Valley

Seddon VFB is this year hosting our mountain biking event on November 22. This year there is a "Poker Run" aspect to it where each competitor will collect a card from 5 different sites along the route with the best hand winning a prize back at the Seddon Fire Station. The trophy this year will go to the Firefighter with the fastest time downhill with 5 cards collected with another prize open to everyone for overall best poker hand collected. The event this year starts at the 1693m summit of the Black Birch Range in the Awatere Valley and follows the summit road back down to the carpark. Riders and their bikes will be shuttled to the summit before the start. Be prepared for some epic views as you descend the 10km gravel road. Safety gear will be a must but this ride can be undertaken by any level of rider. In 2026, this event will revert back to Labour Weekend over in Golden Bay prior to the national event.
